This day came on to be heard the application of Midora Neel to probate the last will and testament of J.L.Neel deceased, and it a appearing to the court that notice and creation has been dely posted as required by law, and it further appearing to the court that the instrument now exhibited to the Court is the last will and testament of J.L. Neel, deceased, and that the said J.D.Neel departed this life about the day of March/1900 in Dallas County, Texas: and that the said J.D.Neel had executed said last will one the 20 day of "eb"y, 1900, with J.C.Kearby and J.E.Davis as witnesses thereto: and it further appearing to the court from the testimony of the said J.C.Kearby and J.
