approved, it is ordered adjudged
and decreed by the Court that
such survivor Kate M. Bryan be
and she is hereby authorized to
control manage and dispose of such
community property in accordance with
law.

To the Hon. T.F. Nash County Judge of Dallas County:-

Your petitioner, Kate M. Bryan, respectfully represents
that her husband L.A. Bryan, a resident of the county of Dallas
and state of Texas, departed this life intestate, in the county
of Dallas and state of Texas on the 4th day of June 1895, leaving
him surviving, his son, Earl Keaton Bryan, aged 8 years
on the 16th day of Aug. 1895. That said L.A. Bryan was seized
and possessed of real and personal estate situate in the
county of Dallas and state of Texas, the same being Community
property of said L.A. Bryan and your petitioner.

That your petitioner desires to have exclusive management,
control, and disposition of said Community property.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that your honor appoint
commissioners to appraise said Community estate and for
all such other and further orders as may be proper &c, &c.
