The application of R. L. Brown, respectfully shows to the Court that - Your petitioner applicant is a resident Citizen of Travis County and State of Texas. That heretofore on or about the day of July 1891 one M. W. Goode, who then resided and had his domicile in the County of Dallas, Texas, died intestate in said County, and said decedent died possessed of landed property lying situated in Bosque & Somerville Counties in said State viz. about 2300 acres - of the probable value of ten thousand dollars - but had no other property known to applicant.

That your applicant was and is a Creditor of said ~~decedent~~ decedent in a large amount of the purchase money for said lands secured by vendors lien thereon, and that a necessity exists for an administration upon said Estate in order that said indebtedness may be paid off. That by reason of the premises your applicant is entitled to letters of administration upon said Estate, and is not disqualified by law. - That there is no other person known to your applicant to be first entitled to such letters, and there is no such administration pending - That the names and residences of the heirs of said decedent, if any are unknown to your applicant.
