And this Guardian reports that on the 15th day
of March 1883 he loaned to A. L. Perry the
sum of \$1700⁰⁰ of his moneys funds for 12
months with interest at 12% per annum
from date until paid, that said Perry exe-
cuted his promissory note for said sum with
Mild Perry & J. E. Stone as his sureties, and
further secured said note by deed of trust
on 106 1/2 acres of land, which said deed of trust
is duly recorded in Vol 3 on pages 436, 437 & 438 -
Dallas County Records &c.

persen on the 6th day of February 1883 the sum
of three hundred dollars at 12% from date

in January 11th 1885 -

And this Guardian reports unto the Court
(and so Charges and Credits himself) that
on the 2nd day of January 1885 that he
loaned to John F. Broxton the sum of
Five Hundred dollars at two years
with 12% per annum interest payable
annually. That the said sum is secured
upon land near the City of Dallas, and
the personal security of Thomas Field
& C. A. Hill - That said loan was approved
by your Honor.

That on the 6th day of February 1885 he
loaned to J. V. Ryan the sum of Seven
Hundred and fifty dollars at one year
after date which was secured by real
estate situated in Dallas County Texas
and the note secured by J. J. Mendenhall
& J. B. Wallace & T. Paer. which said
loan was also approved by your Honor.

And that on April 10th 1885 he
loaned to P. P. Johnson the sum
of Eight Hundred dollars at three
years after date with 12% per ann
interest due and payable annually
said loan secured by deed of trust
in Ellis County Texas and the note
secured by W. B. Brogdon & Thomas
Little.
