

- 14 ShareLunker Overlook Look out over the Lunker Bunker and watch the biologists working with this season's collection of 13+ pound bass.
- 15 Anheuser-Busch Theater and Dive Show Movie and interactive dive show daily Tuesday- Friday at 11 a.m., Saturday at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m., and Sunday at 2 p.m.
- 16 Gift Shop Pick out a unique gift for a friend or a souvenir for yourself.
- 17 Tram Ride (weather permitting) Catch a guided tram tour of the outdoor hatchery ponds after the dive show.
- 18 Casting Pond and Angler Pavilion Free fishing for channel catfish, bluegill or rainbow trout. We supply rods, bait and instruction.
