

Park Boundary

Please Note:

- CHECK OUT time is 2 p.m. or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending site availability).
- · Public consumption or display of an open container of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- A maximum of eight people permitted per campsite. Guests must leave the park by 10 p.m. Quiet time is from 10 p.m. - 6 a.m.
- · Excess parking fee is required at campsites with more than two vehicles (including trailers).
- · Campsite must be kept clean; all trash must be picked up before you leave. Dumpsters are conveniently located on all camping loops.
- · Pets must be on a leash no longer than six feet and under control at all times. Pets are not allowed in any buildings or the beach area.

- GRAY WATER AND BLACK WATER MUST BE DISCHARGED ONLY AT APPROPRIATE SITES.
- · Only one unit per site is permitted to hook up to utilities.
- · Pole and line fishing only.
- · Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
- · All plants and wildlife protected by law.
- · Valid permit is required on windshield of each vehicle in park. All vehicles must remain on pavement.
- Numbered sites are for overnight camping only. NO PICNICKING.
- · Permit required for all areas.
