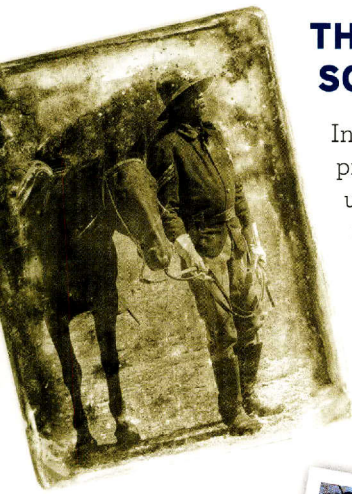

THE BUFFALO SOLDIER LEGACY

In 1867, Congress created the first professional African American units. The men of the 9th and 10th Cavalry, and the 24th and 25th Infantry, served with pride and courage. They served in Texas from 1867–1886 before moving further west. Eventually they became known as the “Buffalo Soldiers.”
