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ANGLER EDUCATION

GRANDPA, CAN WE GO FISHING?

- contains a multitude of messages detailing how everyone can contribute to a better outdoors, higher quality fishing experience and a brighter future for our fisheries resources.

- the theme of the video is anglers have to learn to become detectives, to look for clues about fish and the environment. Underwater footage helps viewers understand the clues.

- gives the first-time angler all he or she needs to know to be successful the first time out.

BOATER EDUCATION

ADVENTURES IN BOATING WITH BILL NYE THE SCIENCE GUY

- filmed in Washington state with popular and comical science teacher Bill Nye, this entertaining video covers water safety including boating responsibility, ethics, safety on the water and hypothermia.

BOATING BASICS

- provides the first time boater a complete introduction to boating and all the basic information he or she needs to know – corresponds with each chapter in the *Texas Boater Education manual*.

JUDGEMENT ON THE WATER

- aimed at the non-traditional boaters, such as fishermen, hunters and campers. This film presents realistic dramatizations, each a classic small boat mishap. The film also analyzes boating accidents and how they can be avoided.

SWEPT AWAY

- a comprehensive training film that clearly explains through demonstrations the safest and most effective water rescue techniques.

HUNTER EDUCATION

A QUESTION OF HUNTING

- candid and thought-provoking dialogue presented by both pro-hunting and anti-hunting segments. A historical overview of hunting and wildlife management in America is shown.

- covers bowhunting basics, equipment selection, techniques, safety, bowhunting responsibility, shot placement and game recovery.

BALANCING NATURE...

TRAPPING IN TODAY'S WORLD

- senator goes fact finding and researching issues on the topic of trapping. The senator interviews a sheep rancher, wildlife officials and a veterinarian during her quest for a fair resolution of trapping in today's world.

BASIC SHOTGUN SHOOTING:

A BETTER WAY

- shows a proven way of teaching the basics of shotgun shooting in a step-by-step method.

BEFORE YOU HUNT

- centers around the veteran hunter, Al, the novice, Barney and his dog, Morgan. Al teaches Barney about the history of hunting and wildlife conservation. Firearm rules, courtesy and responsibility messages are portrayed during pheasant and waterfowl hunts.

BIG GAME HUNTING IN COLORADO

- gives tips on choosing the best place to hunt, how to apply for a drawing license and purchase of regular season license, how to hire an outfitter and where to find maps.

BOWHUNTING: A TIMELESS TRADITION

- teaches the novice bowhunter about personal safety, selection and preparation of equipment, hunting techniques and the necessity for patience.

COLORADO DEER HUNTING

- this action-packed video tells you where to concentrate your efforts to get that trophy buck, how to react to weather, hunting pressure and much more.

COLORADO ELK HUNTING

- techniques and tips for archery, muzzleloading and rifle hunters, how weather affects elk movements, equipment tips and how to field dress an elk.

CONTINUING HERITAGE:

AN AGENCY OVERVIEW

- looks at the general responsibilities and operations of Public Lands, Fisheries and Wildlife, Conservation Communications, Law Enforcement, Resource Protection, Human Resources, Chief Financial Office and Legal Services Divisions of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department.

DEER HUNTING... FOCUS ON ETHICS

- depicts hunting scenes that often give hunters a bad name. This program is intended for all deer hunters in Texas.

FIREARM RESPONSIBILITY

- stresses shooting, hunting, and firearm responsibility found in the department's hunter education manual. Compares safe handling techniques with those in other sports.

FIREARM SAFETY AND THE HUNTER

- illustrates types of hunting accidents and explains the causes. Demonstrates how poor judgement on the part of the shooter, improper gun handling and violations of basic safety rules cause accidents.

FIREARM SAFETY BEGINS IN THE HOME

- emphasizes basic handling, safety and storage of firearms inside the home. Includes a basic test to help determine how much the student knows about general firearm safety. Good for young students.

..... VHS - 22 minutes

FROM THE FIELD TO THE TABLE

- takes students through field dressing, skinning and quartering of a bull elk. It also shows how to cape a trophy head in the field and how to process and cook your game.

..... VHS - 60 minutes

HUNTER SAFETY IS NO ACCIDENT

- depicts interviews with actual hunting accident victims and shooters. No actors were used. It shows how hunting accidents can, and do, change lives.

..... VHS - 21 minutes

LEAD POISONING IN WATERFOWL

- explores the issue of lead poisoning in waterfowl. Discusses problems, symptoms and solutions as they pertain to use of non-toxic shot by hunters.

..... VHS - 28 minutes

MODERN FIREARMS

- examines the parts and functions of rifles, handguns and shotguns. It canvases the various actions, safeties, magazines, sights, chokes and ammunition most commonly used by hunters.

..... VHS - 24 minutes

MUZZLELOADING SAFETY

- highlights muzzleloading firearms in America and demonstrates correct and safe ways to load, fire and clean muzzleloading rifles, shotguns and pistols.

..... VHS - 27 minutes

SAFEGUARDING OUR HERITAGE

- a guide to responsible hunting video used in the Home Study Course. Safe hunting behaviors are demonstrated in several scenes.
..... VHS - 36 minutes

SHOOT/DON'T SHOOT

- designed to help bridge the gap between the classroom and hunting situations in the field. Each sequence filmed from the hunter's view gives the students seven seconds to make a decision to shoot or not to shoot.

SURVIVAL

- recreates true accounts of those individuals who have survived or perished in the "wild" including hunters, fishermen and campers. Gives tips on how to prepare for the outdoors and prevent HYPOTHERMIA.
..... VHS - 28 minutes

THE MEASURE OF THE HUNT –

HUNTER'S PATH (Requires pre-approval.)

- depicts hunting situations designed to "trigger" a response from the students so that the instructor can lead the class in a discussion of a broad range of hunter responsibility issues.
..... VHS - 27 minutes

THE RESPONSIBLE HUNTER

- involves students in self-evaluation and decision-making processes vital to the development of responsible hunter behavior. Covers the five progressive "phases of hunting."

THE TEXAS GAME WARDEN

- gives a realistic look at Texas Game Wardens and their duties.
..... VHS - 11 minutes

WHAT THEY SAY ABOUT HUNTING

- a slide video narrated by Pat Sommerall to help students better understand their role and responsibilities in the public's acceptance of the sport of hunting.
..... VHS - 25 minutes

WILDLIFE CONSERVATION

A HOME FOR PEARL

- teaches children about wildlife habitat and heightens their awareness of what wildlife needs to survive. The difference between wild and domestic animals, urban wildlife, predators, endangered species, and the effects of habitat loss are also depicted.

..... VHS - 70 minutes

BUILDING TOMORROW

- introduces students to modern resource management concepts and to better understand their role in effective wildlife resource management.

..... VHS - 27 minutes

IN CELEBRATION OF AMERICA'S WILDLIFE

- an enjoyable account of how the Pittman-Robertson Act has benefited the reestablishment of meaningful numbers of America's wildlife species.

..... VHS - 57 minutes

QUEST FOR QUALITY

- discusses range for ages and the different requirements for various range animals and shows ways of improving range conditions to benefit the deer herd along with commercial livestock.

..... VHS - 27 minutes

TEXAS TURKEYS - A SYMBOL OF SURVIVAL

- shows the wildlife management techniques used in raising the population of wild turkeys in Texas from near extinction to a very viable hunting resource.

..... VHS - 28 minutes

TEXAS WETLANDS - A LEARNING ADVENTURE

- narrated by middle school youth, this video teaches the nature and role of Texas wetlands, loss of wetland habitat, and efforts to study and rebuild this vital resource. Features the Adopt-A-Wetland learning program.

..... VHS - 10 minutes

TEXAS WILDLIFE

- the wonderful diversity and beauty of Texas wildlife and scenery is showcased using still photographs. Background music and some narration is also included.

..... VHS - 13 minutes

THREATENED/ENDANGERED SPECIES

- an informative slide video that provides an overview of many of the threatened and endangered species that occur in Texas. Information about the current status and reasons for decline are provided.

**UNENDANGERED SPECIES -
THE SUCCESS OF WILDLIFE
MANAGEMENT IN NORTH AMERICA**

- chronicles the history and success of wildlife management in the United States. It provides definitions of basic wildlife management concepts and examines the causes of animal population declines in the early part of the 20th century. It also explains how modern wildlife management techniques allowed these populations to recover, and emphasizes that game animal numbers are healthy and increasing.

WILDLIFE FOR TOMORROW

- shows how farming, ranching and civilization in America affected wildlife. Sportsmen stepped in and helped finance wildlife management programs to ensure wildlife for tomorrow.

..... VHS - 30 minutes

WILDLIFE HABITAT AND THE HUNTER

- stars Al and Barney in discussions of habitat, ecotones and wildlife population and dynamics. It stresses topics in wildlife management, ethics and conservation.

WORRIES OF THE WHITETAIL

- depicts some of the wildlife management techniques used by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department in managing the whitetail deer herd and blending it with the total environment.

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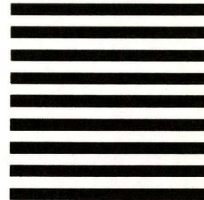
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
