Amend **SB 1026** (introduced version) in ARTICLE 1 of the bill, in SECTION 1.04, as follows:

(1) In proposed Section 8504.104(a)(8), Special District Local Laws Code (page 363, line 23), strike "meet".

(2) In proposed Section 8504.106(c), Special District Local Laws Code (page 365, line 12), strike "that is" and substitute "and all other rights that are".

The amendment to SB 1026 was read and was adopted by a viva voce vote.

On motion of Senator Duncan and by unanimous consent, the caption was amended to conform to the body of the bill as amended.
