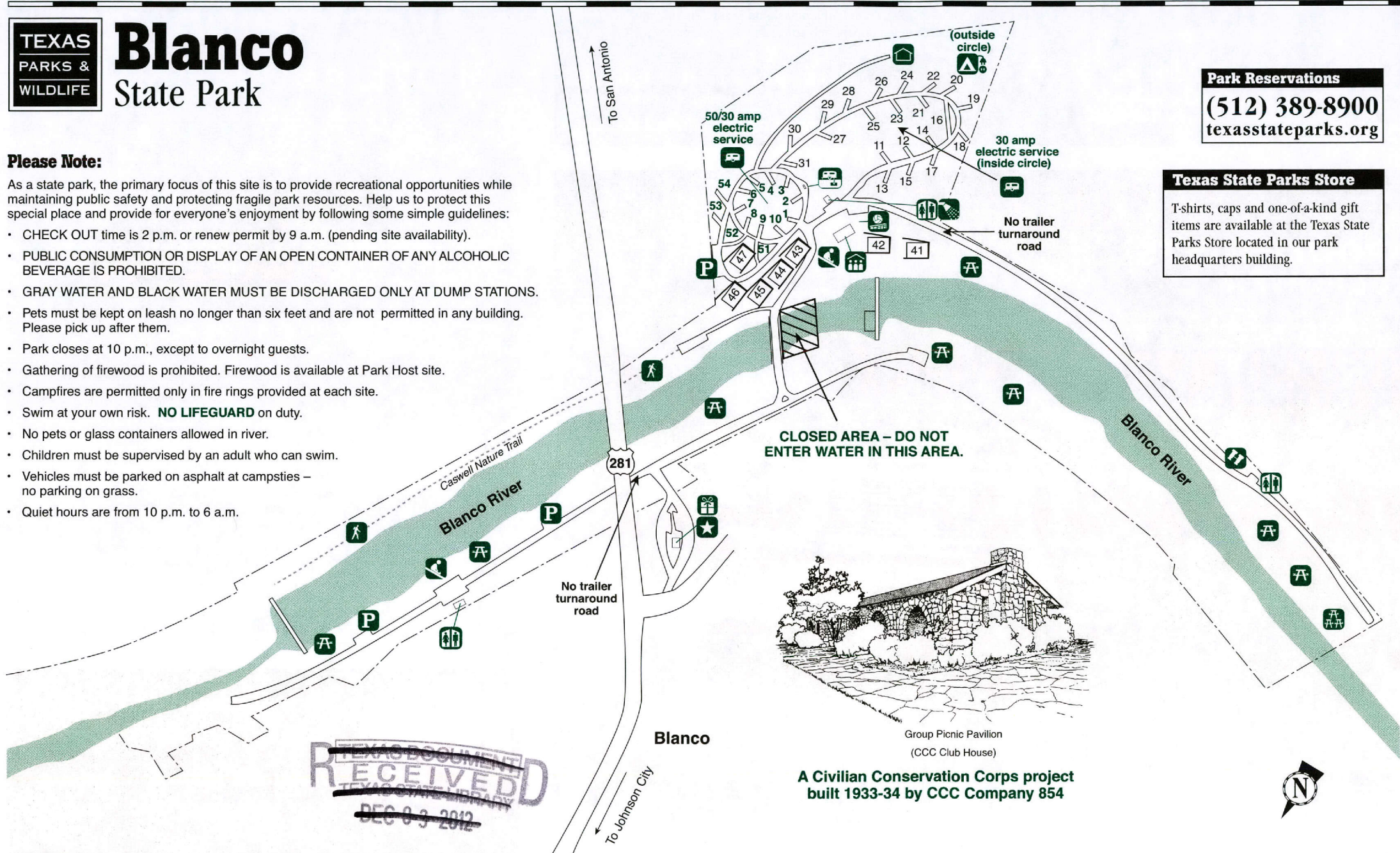


Blanco State Park

Please Note:

As a state park, the primary focus of this site is to provide recreational opportunities while maintaining public safety and protecting fragile park resources. Help us to protect this special place and provide for everyone's enjoyment by following some simple guidelines:

- CHECK OUT time is 2 p.m. or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending site availability).
- PUBLIC CONSUMPTION OR DISPLAY OF AN OPEN CONTAINER OF ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE IS PROHIBITED.
- GRAY WATER AND BLACK WATER MUST BE DISCHARGED ONLY AT DUMP STATIONS.
- Pets must be kept on leash no longer than six feet and are not permitted in any building. Please pick up after them.
- Park closes at 10 p.m., except to overnight guests.
- Gathering of firewood is prohibited. Firewood is available at Park Host site.
- Campfires are permitted only in fire rings provided at each site.
- Swim at your own risk. **NO LIFEGUARD** on duty.
- No pets or glass containers allowed in river.
- Children must be supervised by an adult who can swim.
- Vehicles must be parked on asphalt at campsties – no parking on grass.
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

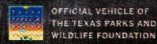
