## TEXAS VETERANS COMMISSION

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The following is an official report showing the amount of monetary benefits paid by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to veterans, dependents and survivors in Texas during Federal Fiscal Year 2006. The report is broken down by county.

**Please note the following:**

- All monetary expenditure figures are in thousands of dollars (\$000).
- Veteran population estimated as of September 30, 2006. Data from VA Office of the Actuary. Data is unrounded.
- Expenditures for "Compensation & Pension" and "Education & Voc-Rehab" categories reflect the dollar value of actual payments made to individuals.
- The "Compensation & Pension" category includes expenditures for the following programs: veterans' compensation for service-connected disability; dependency and indemnity compensation for service-connected deaths; veterans' pension for nonservice-connected disabilities and pension to veterans' surviving spouse and children.
- The "Medical Expenditure" category includes medical services, medical administration, facility maintenance cost, educational support, research support and other overhead items. Medical Expenditure does not include construction or other non-medical support activities.
- VA did not provide us with expenditures for "Construction & Related Costs" or "Insurance & Indemnities." These figures will be available from VA in a separate report at a later date.

We feel that this information is important, as it is an excellent barometer of the effectiveness of the valuable service performed for Texas veterans, their dependents and survivors by the County Veterans Service Officers and Veterans Counselors in the State. Most of the monetary benefits paid are placed in immediate circulation, thereby providing a significant economic stimulus to the Texas economy.

We hope that you will share this information with the County Commissioners Court and the residents of the county in which the service is provided.

We would also like to congratulate all of you for a job well done for the State's veterans, their dependents and survivors.
