ALL ABOUT WATER

Water is the most common substance on Earth, yet only 1 percent of it is fresh water for drinking and using! The rest is either frozen or salty in the seas and ocean.

SAVE THE WATER!

We can't survive without fresh water, so each of us needs to do what we can to conserve and protect this valuable resource.

What can YOU do?

- Turn off faucets when brushing your teeth. (Most people use nearly 2 gallons of fresh water to brush their teeth.)
- Take a shorter shower. (A 5-minute shower uses 25-50 gallons of fresh water.)
- Install a low-flow showerhead or turn off the water while you "suds up."
