- Submit 8578 ID/RC assessments.
- Submit initial, renewal or revision, and transfer Individual Plans of Care (IPCs), Individual Movement Forms for client assignments, and Provider Location Update forms on the LTC Online Portal.
- Take the necessary steps to correct forms and assessments that do not successfully process.
