H.B. No. 745

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the installation of solar-powered stop signs by a  
3 property owners' association.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 430.002, Transportation Code, is amended  
6 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 430.002. [~~SPEED—FEEDBACK~~] SIGNS ERECTED BY  
8 NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION. (a) In this section, "property owners'  
9 association" means an association described by Section 204.004,  
10 Property Code.

11 (b) A property owners' association may install a speed  
12 feedback sign or a solar-powered light-emitting diode (LED) stop  
13 sign on a road, highway, or street in the association's  
14 jurisdiction if:

15 (1) the association receives the consent of the  
16 governing body of the political subdivision that maintains the  
17 road, highway, or street for the placement of the sign; and

18 (2) the association pays for the installation of the  
19 sign.


20 (c) A property owners' association that installs a [~~speed~~  
21 ~~feedback~~] sign under this section is responsible for the  
22 maintenance of the sign.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.




