- 17 road, highway, or street for the placement of the sign; and
- 18 (2) the association pays for the installation of the

- 20 (c) A property owners' association that installs a [speed
- 21 feedback] sign under this section is responsible for the
- 22 maintenance of the sign.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
