4	SECTION 1. Section 1301.002, Occupations Code, is amended
5	by amending Subdivisions (1-a), (2), (3), and (4) and adding
6	Subdivision (1-b) to read as follows:
7	(1-a) "Control valve" means a valve that operates each
8	time water is supplied to, or shut off from, a receptacle or
9	plumbing fixture. The term does not include a stop valve that may be

(A) has worked as a plumber's apprentice under

- 2 (B) has fulfilled the requirements of and is
- 3 registered with the board; and
- 4 (C) clears obstructions in sewer and drain lines
- 5 through any code-approved existing opening under the supervision of
- 6 a responsible master plumber.
- 7 (4) "Journeyman plumber" means a person licensed under
- 8 this chapter who:
- 9 (A) has met the qualifications for registration
- 10 as a plumber's apprentice or for licensing as a tradesman
- 11 plumber-limited license holder;
- 12 (B) has completed at least 8,000 hours working
- 13 under the supervision of a responsible master plumber;
- 14 (C) installs, changes, repairs, services, or
- 15 renovates plumbing or supervises any of those activities under the
- 16 supervision of a responsible master plumber;
- 17 (D) has passed the required examination; and
- 18 (E) has fulfilled the other requirements of the
- 19 board.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 1301.151(a), Occupations Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) The Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners consists of
- 23 nine members appointed by the governor with the advice and consent
- 24 of the senate as follows:
- 25 (1) one member who has at least 10 years' practical
- 26 experience and is licensed as a master plumber;
- 27 (2) one member who has at least five years' practical

- 1 experience and is licensed as a journeyman plumber;
- 2 (3) one member who has at least five years' practical
- 3 experience and is licensed as a plumbing inspector;
- 4 (4) one member who has been a responsible master
- 5 plumber for at least five years [is a plumbing contractor] with at
- 6 least 10 [five] years' experience as a licensed journeyman plumber
- 7 <u>or master plumber;</u>
- 8 (5) one member who is a licensed engineer practicing
- 9 in the field of plumbing engineering;
- 10 (6) two members who are building contractors with at
- 11 least five years' contracting experience, one of whom is
- 12 principally engaged in home building and one of whom is principally
- 13 engaged in commercial building; and
- 14 (7) two members who represent the public.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 1301.202(a), Occupations Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) The board shall employ one or more plumbing examiners.
- 18 A plumbing examiner serves at the will of the board. A plumbing
- 19 examiner must:
- 20 (1) hold a license as a plumber issued under this
- 21 chapter;
- 22 (2) be knowledgeable of this chapter and municipal
- 23 ordinances relating to plumbing; and
- 24 (3) be qualified by experience and training in

- SECTION 4. Section 1301.354(c), Occupations Code, is
- 27 amended to read as follows:

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- 1 (c) At the applicant's request, the board may credit an
- 2 applicant under Subsection (b) with up to 1,000 [500] hours of the
- 3 work experience required before taking an examination if the
- 4 applicant has completed the classroom portion of a training

- 6 (1) approved by the United States Department of Labor,
- 7 Office of Apprenticeship; or

- SECTION 5. (a) The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 11 only to an application for a certificate of registration as a drain
- 12 cleaner or drain cleaner-restricted registrant submitted on or
- 13 after the effective date of this Act. An application for a
- 14 certificate of registration submitted before the effective date of
- 15 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 16 application was submitted, and the former law is continued in
- 17 effect for that purpose.

- 19 drain cleaner or drain cleaner-restricted registrant issued before

- (c) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an
- 25 application for a license as a journeyman plumber submitted on or
- 26 after the effective date of this Act. An application for a license
- 27 submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the

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- 1 law in effect on the date the application was submitted, and the
- 2 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 (d) A person who holds a license as a journeyman plumber
- 4 issued before the effective date of this Act may continue to renew
- 5 that license without complying with the changes in law made by this
- 6 Act relating to the work requirement under the supervision of a
- 7 responsible master plumber.
- 8 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 9 1301.151(a), Occupations Code, does not affect the entitlement of a
- 10 member serving on the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners
- 11 immediately before the effective date of this Act to continue to
- 12 serve as a member of the board for the remainder of the member's
- 13 term. The change in law applies only to a member appointed on or
- 14 after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
