Section 28.022, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 8 (e) A district that uses an electronic platform for communicating student grade and performance information to parents 9 may permit a parent to sign a notice required under Subsections 10 (a)(2) and (a)(3) electronically, so long as the district retains a 11 record verifying the parent's acknowledgment of the required 12 notice. A district that accepts electronic signatures under this 13 subsection must offer parents the option to provide a handwritten 14 15 signature as provided under Subsection (b). SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
