- 12 branch of the federal government, when being operated by or for the
- 13 transportation of:
- 14 (1) the person who registered the vehicle under
- 15 Section 504.202(a), <u>504.308</u>, [Section] 504.310, 504.315, [Ox]
- 16 504.316, or 504.319;
- 17 (2) a person described in Section 504.202(b) if the
- 18 vehicle is registered under that subsection; or
- 19 (3) the owner or operator of a vehicle displaying
- 20 license plates described by Subsection (a)(2).
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
