- 9 collect fees under the terms of this section until the resolution is
- 10 rescinded.
- 11 (h) A fee established under a particular resolution is
- 12 abolished on the earlier of:
- 13 (1) the date a resolution adopted under Subsection (e)
- 14 is rescinded as provided by Subsection (g); or
- 15 (2) July 1, 2030 [<del>2016</del>].
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
