H.B. No. 1237

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 290 in Hays  
3 and Travis Counties as the Lieutenant Clay Crabb Memorial Highway.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
6 is amended by adding Section 225.102 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 225.102. LIEUTENANT CLAY CRABB MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)


8 The portion of U.S. Highway 290 between its intersection with  
9 Circle Drive in Travis County and its intersection with Hays  
10 Country Acres Road in Hays County is designated as the Lieutenant  
11 Clay Crabb Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any  
12 other designation.

13 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:


14 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
15 designation as the Lieutenant Clay Crabb Memorial Highway and any  
16 other appropriate information; and

17 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
18 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.







**IN RE: HB1237** by Tinderholt (Relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 290 in Hays and Travis Counties as the Lieutenant Clay Crabb Memorial Highway.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to design, construct, and erect highway markers designating a portion of U.S. Highway 290 as the Lieutenant Clay Crabb Memorial Highway, subject to Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code.

Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code, specifies that TxDOT is not required to design, construct, or erect the marker unless a grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the cost. Based on the information provided by TxDOT, it is assumed any duties associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**
