

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 16 in
3 Young County as the Texas Game Warden Joseph Marshall Evans
4 Memorial Highway.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
7 is amended by adding Section 225.106 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 225.106. TEXAS GAME WARDEN JOSEPH MARSHALL EVANS
9 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of State Highway 16 in Young
10 County from the Palo Pinto County line northwest to the municipal
11 limits of Graham is designated as the Texas Game Warden Joseph
12 Marshall Evans Memorial Highway.

13 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

14 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
15 highway number, the designation as the Texas Game Warden Joseph
16 Marshall Evans Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate
17 information; and

18 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
19 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

IN RE: SB288 by Estes (Relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 16 in Young County as the Texas Game Warden Joseph Marshall Evans Memorial Highway.),
Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to design, construct, and erect highway markers designating a portion of State Highway 16 as the Texas Game Warden Joseph Marshall Evans Memorial Highway, subject to Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code.

Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code, specifies that TxDOT may not design, construct, or erect the marker unless a grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the cost. Based on the analysis of TxDOT, it is assumed any duties associated with the implementation of the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
