9	(1) audible to the public at the location specified in
10	the notice of the meeting as the location of the meeting;
11	(2) broadcast over the Internet in the manner
12	prescribed by Section 551.128; and
13	(3) [shall be] recorded and[. The recording shall be]
14	made available to the public <u>in an online archive located on the</u>
15	Internet website of the entity holding the meeting.
16	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
17	a meeting for which notice is posted under Section 551.043,
18	Government Code, on or after the effective date of this Act.
19	Meetings for which notice is posted before the effective date of
20	this Act are governed by the law in effect at that time.
21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.


