1 AN ACT

2 relating to notice of cancellation of elections.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 2.081, Election Code, is amended by
5 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:


6 (c) A county election officer, as defined by Section 31.091,
7 may use a single combined notice of cancellation under Subsection
8 (b) for all authorities:

9 (1) for which the officer provides election services
10 under contract; and


11 (2) that declare an election moot under Subsection
12 (a).

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.




