- 8 (d) A municipality may exempt property owned by a religious
- 9 organization that is exempt from taxation pursuant to Section
- 10 11.20, Tax Code, from <u>all or a portion of</u> drainage charges under
- 11 this subchapter, as the governing body of the municipality
- 12 considers appropriate:
- 13 (d-1) A municipality may exempt property used for cemetery
- 14 purposes from drainage charges under Section 552.047 if the
- 15 cemetery is closed to new interments and does not accept new
- 16 burials.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
